

Newman Selective



The Newman Selective Gifted Education Program is an initiative of Sydney Catholic Schools which

commenced six years ago with a small group of schools and Holy Spirit has joined those schools with a Newman Selective Stream. This class is specially designed to cater for the unique learning needs of Gifted and Highly Capable Learners.

Students placed in the Newman Selective Stream study English, Mathematics, Science, History, Religious Education and PDHPE together. We select a group of students who are gifted or highly capable learners and these students are identified using a variety of data. Once identified these students are invited to be a member of the Newman Selective Gifted Education Program.

The teachers of these classes are all qualified to support students who are gifted or highly capable and have completed specific training with GERRIC, the Gifted Education Research, Resource and Information Centre at the University of New South Wales.
